Short Description:

How do characters make their way from the pages of children's literature to the Broadway stage? Wendy's musical theatre draws on examples from well-known children's favorites, such as protagonist Peter Pan, supporting character the Fairy Godmother, antagonist Captain Hook, and the goals of Princess Winnifred in *The Princess and the Pea*, to help students discover the key elements around which stories are developed. Wendy uses her theatrical skills to demonstrate how actors and writers create a character's personality using voice, physical movements, and facial expressions as budding actors from the audience crow, chant, and mime along.
