

FROM THE WRITERS

In the early 1930s, Marie Baker and her "Pants Gang" marauded the streets of Miami, just pantsing with abandon. After she was caught (reportedly because she took a little too much time reapplying her lipstick), she went to prison for 3 years and disappeared into obscurity-and that's about all there was. But we still wanted to dig beyond the headlines into the historical context (shout out Miami-Dade Archives), and we became really fascinated by the climate in Miami at the time. H. Leslie Quigg. the police chief, was an open member of the KKK and was even indicted (and quickly released) for lynching a Black bellboy. That, in combination with the heavy mob presence, racial climate and wealth disparity created a pretty powerful backdrop for our story. And so, one woman's journey toward selfdiscovery became a representation of a whole community trying to seize their power back. Listening to the voices of generous BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, or People of Color) friends and colleagues and other women, as well as working with this exceptional cast, has helped bring history forwardwhere everything has changed, yet everything has stayed the same.

There could've been a lot of reasons Marie pantsed her victims—so they couldn't chase after her, or to grab headlines—but we asked a deeper question. What kind of woman felt the need to humiliate men in this way? She wasn't grabbing big

money, she wasn't committing violence... so in our minds there had to be something more. Drawing on deeply personal and tangential experience, we gave Marie her story. She was a woman fleeing a life where what she wore, did, said, even thought was wrestled from her control. And one day? She walked out. But that wasn't the end for her-she recklessly and boldly took her journey of rediscovery to the streets. Most folk heroes have a tricky journey--often one that's not so morally black and white. They demand sacrifice and compromise and single-minded devotion—and it takes a lot for a gal to get noticed. Big leaps require big actions. Yes, we want you to have a great time, we want you to laugh and we want you to leave humming/ singing/screlting our tunes. Life is hard. And hilarious. Difficult and beautiful. And most of the good stuff happens in the gray moments in between. Our Marie Baker wasn't afraid of those moments. In fact. we're pretty sure she lived in them. And we think she's asking us: What happens when




