ABOUT THE PLAY:

William Makepeace Thackeray's 19th-century novel *Vanity Fair* is subtitled "A Novel Without a Hero," and was intended to satirize the author's society. Set during the Napoleonic Wars, the story follows two school friends - Amelia Sedley, rich & privileged, and Becky Sharp, with a poor & disfavored background. Despite their differences, the two friends both face the same obstacles in navigating love, money, and society expectations. Like the novel, the play is framed as a puppet show or traveling theatre troupe, led by a Manager who commands the storytelling. And like the novel, the play encourages us to question the rules of our own society-the rules of the game we play every day. Playwright Kate Hamill says, "(Classic stories) are, of course, our stories.... They're cultural touchstones. *Vanity Fair* challenges audiences to think that we are not different from these people."

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
